The Role and Influence of Anne Boleyn In 16th century England, the concept of gender equality was entirely foreign to nearly all citizens The idea of organized feminism did not emerge until the mid-19th century, and the influential American feminist movement followed over a hundred years later ("The Women's Movement")

er, Henry VIII of England renounced the papacy and separated the English Church from Rome Aside from a brief restoration of Roman Catholicism under Mary I, the reformed Church of Ireland was the official state church until 1871 This had little effect on most people Large parts of rural Ireland were not in any practical sense under English

### **Courts, Courtiers, and Culture in Tudor England**

He argued that the appointment of Henry VIII's favourites to positions in the privy chamber, beginning with Sir William Compton as Groom of the Stool in 1510, trans-formed the privy chamber structurally and politically Its members assumed a range of financial, administrative, diplomatic, and military duties and, perhaps most importantly,
