Dunkirk Versus History

Dunkirk was largely levelled by the Luftwaffe and German onslaught • The RAF lost 177 planes • Luftwaffe destroyed 243 vessels, including 6 destroyers • The BEF lost 50,000 vehicles (tanks, artillery etc) • France was lost • 1/10th of the soldiers were left behind on the beach • 30,000 French soldiers left behind
